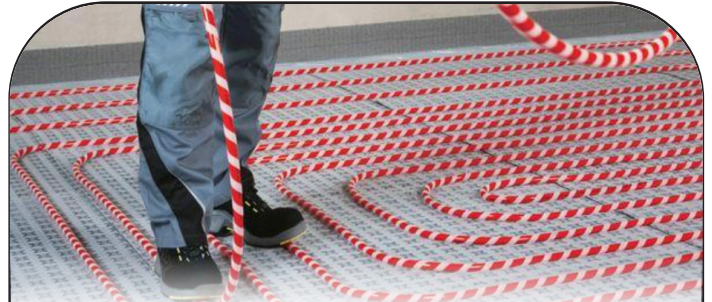

Structural Slabs

Concrete poured over and around the pipe, which is fastened to a structural wire mesh and/or rebar.



Overpour

with a thin layer of gypsum concrete poured over a structural slab or subfloor.



Above-Floor Panels

Low-profile radiant systems install without concrete, are lightweight, work with many floor types, and install quickly using standard framing tools.



Below-Floor Panels

No need to change anything with your existing floor coverings, because plates are placed between the joists from a crawl space or from the ceiling of the floor below.
